The holiday is on November  $1^{\rm st}$  and  $2^{\rm nd}$  every year in 2 cities and towns across Mexico. While the holiday first ) in Mexico, it is also 3 celebrated in other Latin American countries, and cities with large Latino populations, 4 such as Los Angeles, USA. 5 6 The Day of the Dead comes from a mix of cultures. Native Mexican people have honored the dead for over 3000 years. They would leave food and water for the spirits 7 8 of dead family members during the summer. Across the ocean in Spain, a similar holiday called All Souls Day was celebrated. People would offer bread and wine to departed 9 family members in the autumn. When Spanish people reached Mexico in the  $16^{
m th}$ 10 century, the two traditions combined to become the Day of the Dead. 11 ) that the Day of the Dead is like the Japanese holiday Some people ( 12 *Obon.* Both festivals are happy occasions with food, drink, music, and dancing. ( 1) 13 In both countries, families clean the graves of their ancestors and leave flowers or food 14 for them on \*altars in their homes. ( 2) On the other hand, some Day of the Dead 15 traditions are very different from the Japanese Obon holiday. ( $\blacksquare$  3) During the Day of 16 the Dead, people often dress up in fancy costumes and wear make-up to look like 17 skeletons.  $( \blacksquare 4)$ 18 19 Today, the Day of the Dead has become a tourist attraction, and UNESCO made it a 20 cultural World Heritage in 2003. If you visit Mexico during this holiday, you can watch parades and shop for souvenirs decorated with skulls. Some local families even invite 21 tourists to join in their home celebrations. However, tourists are advised to be respectful 22 when dressing. The skeleton make-up is considered an important symbol usually worn 23 only by Mexican Catholics. 24
