1 The Olympic games are the top level of competition for athletes around the world.
2 It is the best way to find out who is the strongest, fastest, and greatest, both in modern
3 times and comparatively to past competitions. Today, nearly all countries around the
4 world support the training of athletes for the Olympics, but this () came from
5 one country.

6 The history of the Olympics began around 3000 years ago in Greece. Originally, it
7 was a six-week athletics festival to honor Zeus, the god of thunder. Some examples of
8 the main events during the festival were running (short distance and long distance),
9 boxing, and *chariot racing. In that era, only men could compete in the events and
10 married women could not even come to watch. Although the festival was very popular, a
11 Christian emperor ended the games around A.D. 400 because Zeus was not a Christian
12 god.

13 The modern version of the Olympics did not start to take form until 1892 when
14 Baron Pierre de Coubertin started a group for international athletics competitions. The
15 result was a new organization called the International Olympic Committee (IOC).
16 Because the Olympics originally took place in Greece, Athens was chosen to be the
17 location of the first Olympic games in 1896. Different from the modern Olympics, only
18 280 athletes joined from 13 countries, only men could compete, and there were no gold
19 medals. Baron Pierre de Coubertin was very strict about the second point. Of course, all
20 these points improved over time. Specifically, the number of participating countries
21 greatly increased, women began to compete from 1900, and the medal system was
22 updated. Furthermore, the Olympic flag with five rings was shown for the first time in
23 1920, each one representing an area of the world, including North and South America,
24 Asia, Africa, Europe, and Australia.

25 Since those early days, the Olympics has changed locations every four years.
26 (■ 1) In 2004, the Olympic games finally returned to Athens with 11,000 athletes

27 competing from 201 countries. (■ 2) This shows how much the Olympics has grown
28 and changed over the last 100 years. (■ 3) Not only has it kept its positive focus on
29 sports, but it has also become a symbol for international cooperation. (■ 4)
