"Self-driving cars" are cars that can run without human drivers. While still in the 1 early stages of development, this new technology is changing the world around us. Self-driving cars have been in () for some time. In the year 2004, the U.S. 3 government made a competition to build driverless cars. By the year 2019, many 4 traditional car companies such as Toyota, BMW, and Mercedes had programs 5 researching self-driving technology. At the same time, newer companies like Waymo 6 and Tesla have been testing different designs and collecting data to improve their 7 self-driving systems. In 2023, self-driving taxi services are already available in several 8 cities in the U.S. 9 So, what benefits can we expect from self-driving technology? For one thing, 10 driverless cars will likely be cheaper than traditional taxis; they will make it easier for 11 poor people and older people to travel. Secondly, they will be safer—once the 12 technology improves, there will be fewer () caused by bad drivers. Of course, 13 self-driving will also allow people to do work or sleep while riding in the car. The 14 cheaper cost of transportation could also help other businesses to move their products. 15 While self-driving cars will change our lives in the near future, there are still 16 17 many problems that need to be solved. First of all, self-driving technology needs to be improved to make sure it is safe and reliable. (1) Governments around the world 18 will also need to make new laws about this technology. (■ 2) Additionally, some 19 traditional industries will change rapidly. (3) Car companies, for example, may 20 not sell as many vehicles as people start using self-driving taxis. (4) 21 Self-driving cars may cause just as much change to society as when the first cars 22 replaced horses. They may seem unbelievable, but perhaps they are not too far away. 23
