         Planting: When the time is right, plant the tomatoes deep in the ground so that

     the leaves are just above the surface. Water your plants regularly to keep the ground a

     little bit wet. You can also feed the plants with fertilizer* every few weeks to keep

     them healthy. Depending on the type of tomatoes you plant, you may also need to cut

     off some of the branches to keep them from growing too big. Tomatoes will change
15
     color and be ready to harvest by the middle of summer. Check your plants every few

     days and (
                        ) the tomatoes as soon as they turn red.
         Problems: (■ 1) While tomatoes are usually easy to grow, they may not produce

     many fruits if it is too rainy and cold. ( 2) Moreover, your plants could be

     damaged by insects and diseases. ( 3) To prevent problems, check your plants

     often and change where you plant your tomatoes each season. (\blacksquare 4)
