1 There have been many missions to the moon in recent years as more countries
2 and private companies develop advanced technology. Landing on the moon is
3 difficult, and while some projects are successful, others fail or are canceled. In this
4 article we review some recent missions and preview missions that may take place in
5 the future.

6 Blue Ghost Mission 1: This mission launched on January 15th, 2025 on a SpaceX
7 Falcon 9 rocket. It was the work of Firefly Aerospace, a private startup ()
8 near Austin, Texas. It followed a long path to the moon before landing on March 2nd.
9 Like many U.S. space missions these days, NASA sent experiments but didn't actually
10 operate the *¹spacecraft.

11 Hakuto-R Mission 2: Operated by the Japanese company ispace, inc., this mission
12 was intended to deliver a *²lander named Resilience to the surface of the moon. It
13 launched on the same SpaceX rocket as Blue Ghost Mission 1. Unfortunately, just
14 before landing on June 6th, communication with the lander was lost; it is thought to
15 have crash-landed on the surface of the moon. The company is studying the data to
16 understand what caused the problem.

17 Chang'e 7: (■ 1) China's national space administration, CNSA, has been
18 making moon landings since 2013, with some recent missions bringing lunar samples
19 back to Earth. (■ 2) In 2026 the Chang'e 7 mission will look for useful resources on
20 the moon, and future missions may include people. (■ 3) Some have pointed this
21 out as a sign of a new space race. (■ 4)

22 However, missions do not () move ahead as planned. For example,
23 *³NASA's Artemis has faced difficulties. The cost to launch one of its rockets has been
24 higher than planned, and future launches may never get off the ground. Despite these
25 challenges, one thing is certain: fans of space have a lot to look forward to in the
26 coming years!
